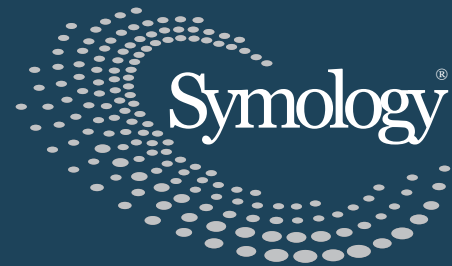


Street Works Register

Pay-per-Works Managed Service



Summary

Symology's Street Works Register "Pay-per-Works" Managed Service provides a comprehensive, low cost, solution to organisations which only record a small number of Works each year, though are still required to comply with the latest Traffic Management Act legislation and associated Street Works Code of Practice.

The "Pay-per-Works" Managed Service enables all the technical overheads and workload, associated with traditional functions relating to database management, upgrades, new installations and re-installations, to be avoided by the Client. Symology hosts the application software and manages all server-side functions.

Utilising thin-client deployment technology, end users can simply connect to the service over the Internet and immediately start using the system.

The "Pay-per-Works" system comes pre-loaded with a full Street Gazetteer for England and Wales. The Gazetteers are managed and maintained by Symology, in line with the latest publications of the National Street Gazetteer from the NSG Hub.

If required, the system can be provided with sophisticated GIS facilities, which enable coordinates to be recorded on opening and registration notices.

The "Pay-per-Works" service includes full electronic noticing capabilities inline with EToN 4 standards, using both FTP and Web Service (XML/SOAP) transfers, to and from the various Highway Authorities and other interested parties. All Works, Comments, Inspections and OD file transactions can also be sent and received. Highway Authority Operational Districts details are maintained for the customer by Symology's Managed Service Team.

Sophisticated reporting tools are provided, which provide all the exception reports required to monitor the progress of Street Works Notices and Fixed Penalties. The results of these enquiries can be exported directly to CSV and XML format and downloaded to the end user's PC.

The embedded Crystal Reports facility provides an additional level of powerful reporting facilities with user defined layouts, sorting, summarising and graph production. The results of these reports can be output in PDF format and e-mailed to any address.

Symology offer full training courses in the use of the system. Regular training courses are staged at our training centres in Caddington, Sheffield, Blackburn and Larbert in Scotland.
